

Rycroft Arena COVID-19 Protocol and Operations REV 6 September 28, 2021

- All individuals entering the facility must remain masked and maintain social distancing measures throughout the building.
- Maximum amount of 50 spectators (1/3 capacity) and off-ice team members permitted. It is the responsibility of the home team to ensure this is followed.
- If anyone (participant, parent, guardian, spectator or coach) is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or have had close contact with someone who has COVID-19 like symptoms, **DO NOT PARTICIPATE OR ENTER THE FACILITY.**
- Players/team officials are to be masked anywhere in the building except for inside the ice surface area, benches and their assigned dressing room. All team members and spectators must exit building no more than 20 minutes after ice session.
- One trainer with **certification** must be present and remain masked.
- Only team members on the ice or in a dressing room at ALL TIMES. **NO others permitted.**
- Absolutely no spitting or nose clearing without tissue anywhere in the building including ice surface and players boxes.
- All patrons will enter through Southeast entrance. NO exit through Southeast doors. Exit from building through Southwest doors.
- No concession services will be operated. Public washrooms are upstairs. Due to the size of the washrooms and to maintain social distancing **NO MORE THAN TWO PEOPLE TO BE IN A WASHROOM AT ANY GIVEN TIME.**

Failure to adhere may result in individuals and/or Cohorts being banned or the facility closing. This document may change as season progresses. Please keep your cohorts informed.
