Notes:	
1. Female on the Bench	One member of the Team Staff of U19 or younger team must be a non-playing female coach, age eighteen (18) or older and present on the bench for all competition.
2. Coach Initiation in Sport	This module is a requirement for all coaches to take before they may register in a CSI or CI clinic.
3. Competition Introduction (CI)	Coaches registering for a CI clinic MUST complete a pre-clinic workbook before the system will allow the participant to register.
4. U12 A, B, C	New coaches: Have the option of completing either CSI clinic or CI clinic
5. Make Ethical Decisions (MED)	Participants must attend a 4-hour clinic (live online or in person) and then must complete the online certification on https://coach.ca/ Participants complete the clinic and once complete, the certification component will be free and is completed on coach.ca <i>Participants who only complete the online certification without having attended a clinic will not be recognized as complete.</i>
6. Standard First Aid or equivalent	All teams must have a bench staff member who has Standard First Aid or equivalent qualification. All U10-U19 must have a registered trainer who fulfills this requirement.
