On-Reserve Composting Program

AIB will be participating in Earth Day 2020.

In compliance with this program we are offering members the opportunity to reduce waste by signing up for our composting program. You will receive a 1 gallon Kitchen Compost Bucket with a locking lid and biodegradable liners to fill with eligible materials such as fruit & veggie scraps, coffee grounds, egg shells, etc. (A complete guide will be issued to all who participate).

The contents of the bucket will be collected once a week to be added to the compost Bins located at the Community Garden.

This is a great way to reduce waste and provide a natural fertilizer and soil conditioner for the garden!

Everyone who participates in this program will be eligible for a prize draw at the end of each month.

Rentals, Lift Tickets, Ski Passes, Food Vouchers, Gas Card & 1 Hotel room per family .


*You must be able and willing to participate in one of the following outdoor activities to qualify ... Skiing, Snowboarding, Tubing, or snowshoeing.
