Policy: ADMHA OFFICIALS SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Purpose: Provide application process and guidelines to administer officials scholarship.

Responsibility: Off-ice Director, Member at Large, Referee and Chief

SELECTION CRITERIA

The successful applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

- A member in good standing with Hockey Canada.
- Resident of the ADMHA boundary area for the past season and the current season.
- A member of Hockey Canada Officiating program for 3 seasons.
- Minimum 18 years of age by December 31 of the current season.
- Active official working games in the ADMHA Region.
- Accepted to a Post-secondary or Trade institution in a recognized program on a full-time basis (min. of three classes per semester).
- Volunteer experience you have provided as a mentor/leader on and off the ice.
- Letter of reference from one current referee.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION COMMITTEE

A scholarship committee will select the winner each year. The committee consists of:

- One ADMHA Executive Member
- ADMHA Member at Large Executive Member
- ADMHA Referee and Chief

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The application period is January 1 to March 31 each year. Applications will not be considered received until all of the required information has been received by the ADMHA Off-ice Director. Application to be sent to iceschedule@admha.com.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

The successful applicant will receive \$500.00.

EVALUATION OF APPLICANTS

Assessment of applicants will be based on but not limited to the follow:

- Commitment to the Program
- Professionalism
- Leadership/volunteer to ADMHA Officiating program
- Volunteer work to ADMHA (on-ice or off-ice)
- Desire to continuing to officiate Hockey
- Overall ability
