- 6.1 New ADMHA Board Structure
 - A meeting to solely discuss this will be held March 14, 2019 at Athabasca Regional Multiplex at 6:00 p.m.
- 6.2 Pool/Fitness Center Request for Donation
 - A request was made for ADMHA to financially support the new Pool/Fitness Center
 - President Pysyk, Kelly Rich and Jocelyn Arthur met with Janene Kargus of Multiplex
 - Janene has applied for a grant to improve arena infrastructure such as ice plant
 - ADMHA Board will wait to hear about success of grant application and will then decide if we want to support the new Pool/Fitness Center
- 6.3 Jerseys for graduating ADMHA Midget players
 - In past years parents of graduating players paid for jerseys
 - Should ADMHA pay for these jerseys?
 - Cost in the past was \$130/jersey with crest and number
 - Quote from Cheap Seats is \$177.95/jersey

6.4 Registration/ Deadlines/Fees

- Change registration deadline to June 30th of each year
- After deadline late registration fee of \$200 is due and player will be placed on a waitlist
- These changes apply to returning players only
- ADMHA will continue to allow a 5 month payment plan option
- 2019-10 Motion by Director Ponich "To change registration deadline to June 30th of each year instead of current date of August 18th for returning players. Further a \$200 late registration fee be charged and player to be placed on waitlist." Seconded- Motion Carried
- Refund of Fees
- ADMHA pays a \$25/player insurance fee to Hockey Alberta. Should this be refunded when a player withdraws from hockey
- If you step on ADMHA ice after September 1st of each year then you do not get the \$25/player insurance fee refunded

 100% of fees will be refunded by ADMHA by October 31st of each year. Need to reexamine policy and if it needs to be changed then a policy form needs to be completed.

7.0 Treasurer- Sandra Hayward

- Ice fees are paid and up to date, rest of financial information is accurate up to end of December 2018
- ADMHA Fee increase- not needed at this time
- Casino booked for July 24-25, 2019
- 13 volunteers are needed
- Approximately \$44,000 is raised for ADMHA
- If ADMHA members volunteer for Casino then they may earn a credit for money off the following year's fees OR volunteer hours are considered complete for 2 hockey season
- An incentive is needed because each year it is harder to find enough volunteers to cover casino shifts
- Sandra will organize and keep track of Casino volunteers
