## GAME CONSIDERATIONS CHECKLIST

# **HOST ASSOCIATION: LEVEL: Athabasca Minor Hockey**

The following considerations provide a checklist for a host team/ association to communicate relevant information to the teams, spectators and timekeepers prior to any games. It is important that the host communicates with its facility so that any specific guidelines/ regulations in place for that facility are shared with visiting team(s).

#### Teams

- MASKING REQUIREMENTS
  - Within the municipality
  - o Within the facility

Masking is required within the arena.

- ENTRY AND EXIT PROCESS
  - o Time restrictions Must arrive no more than 20 minutes early and must exit the facility no later than 20 mins after the game is finished.
  - Specific doors you will enter and exit through the main doors, please follow the arrows and used the appropriate door that is marked enter or exit
- DRESSING ROOM ACCESS
  - Participant maximums-no maximums but only players and coaches permitted in the dressing
  - o Time restrictions prior to or after games? Arrive no earlier than 20 minutes prior to the game and exit no later than 20 mins after the game has ended
  - Is shower access allowed?- NO shower access
  - o Are parents allowed to access? no parents permitted in the dressing rooms unless it is an emergency. If a parent needs to go in for an emergency, the parent must wear a mask while in the room.
- WARM UP/COOL DOWN SPACE AVAILABILITY –warm up/cool down space will be permitted inside the arena outside of the dressing rooms.
- ACCESS TO WATER BOTTLE FILL STATIONS in all dressing rooms
- PLAYERS AND TEAM OFFICIALS FACILITY ACCESS (HALLWAYS, LOBBY, SPECTATOR AREA) – no access to the lobby, there is access for spectators although numbers are limited. The home team manager will let the visiting team know how many spectators will be permitted prior to travelling.
- SKATE SHARPENING / THERAPY TABLE SET UP-no skate sharpening or therapy table.
- EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN-emergency action plan will be accessible in the arena.
- BUS DROP OFF, LOADING AND PARKING-yes there is bus drop off and parking available

• VIDEO SET UP AND LIVE STREAMING (IF APPLICABLE) maximum of 2 people per team will be permitted to set up video or live stream. They must check in at the front desk and remain within the section that is set aside for videoing. Videoing/live streaming will be permitted on the balconies upstairs behind the players benches.

### **Spectators**

- GENERAL FACILITY RESTRICTIONS-spectators will remain inside the arena part of the multiplex and will sit in the designated spectator area
- MANAGEMENT OF SPECTATOR MAXIMUM- the home manager will tell the visiting manager how many spectators may attend with their team prior to them travelling.
- We ask that team mangers bring a list of players/coaches/parents attending as well as oat least one contact number so we can adhere to the contact tracing requirements set out by AHS.
- ENTRY AND EXIT PROCESS
  - Time restrictions arrive no earlier than 20 mins before the game and leave no later than 20 mins after the game has finished
  - Specific doors enter/exit through the main doors and follow the signage
- SPECTATOR SEATING ACCESS –inside the arena in the stands
- ADMISSION FEES AND FORMS OF PAYMENT (IF APPLICABLE) N/A
- CONCESSION SERVICES AVAILABLE NO concession available at this time

#### **Timekeepers**

Must either wear a mask or maintain a minimum 2-metre distance from everyone else. Must adhere to facility protocols (sanitization, audio equipment usage, shared materials)

Maximum of 2 people in the time keeping box at all times. Timekeepers must wear masks
