- 7.1. Financial Reports
 - Wording needs to be fixed on the current registration package as it can be interpreted that the \$100 discount can be claimed if you register Online. Change this to make it clear you need to be at the AGM to receive the discount.
 - Volunteer shifts are unfair when you compare the Casino vs. the ACHC. It
 is difficult to balance people working 2-days at a casino and those working
 only 6 hours at the ACHC. Suggestion can we somehow give a credit
 towards next season registration as well as the hours for volunteer?

- Registration package updates (minor Hockey fees)
 - No current raise in registration fees
 - Suggest that we move registration cut-off date to August 1st instead of the 18th
 - ADMHA can publicize this on the website and run an ad in the Advocate the same as last year (asking for coaches, reminding about the cut-off date).

10.0 Division Directors

- 10.1. Initiation *Matt Leriger*
 - Initiation Tournament date change
 - Book off the dates now for next December for a set tournament early In December instead of the usual Christmas to New Year's date.
 - Athabasca should consider instituting Hockey Alberta's "best practices" which include:
 - Coach to player ration 5:1 is preferable according to Hockey Alberta, this year ADMHA ratio was approximately 10:1
 - Practice time, no earlier than 5:00pm on weeknights; and on weekends, no earlier than 9:00am. Early practice times contribute to poor coach/player ratios. It is difficult to have coaches arrive at 3:50pm.
 - Hockey Albert recommends players be 5-6 years old, not any younger, in the Initiation level.
 - Need to purchase bigger Initiation-sized nets. Erin will research this and discuss storage with the Multiplex. Dimensions are on the Hockey Alberta site
 - Discussion: New minimum age will be set. Players must be 5-years-old as of December 31st of current registration year.
 - Suggest a first-year parent/ new player orientation to talk about equipment needs and expectations to be organized by the Initiation Director and Coaching Director.
