

Tri-County Soccer Association Trialist Form

** TRIALIST FORMS MUST BE SENT TO <u>COMPETITIONS@TRICOUNTY.SOCCER</u> ALONG WITH COMPLETED GAMESHEETS**

- Trialists do NOT need player cards
- Prior written permission must be obtained from a registered team coach or team official with whom the player is currently registered
- It must be recorded on the game sheet that the player is a "Trialist"
- Players may be recruited from a lower age group on a trial basis to a **maximum of 3 players per game**
- Any registered player may play an unlimited number of games for an older age category team within the same parent Community Association for league games only
- This form must be retained by the team and be submitted to the league when sending in game sheets for that game. Failure to provide the necessary form will result in a forfeit for that team NO EXCEPTIONS
- You may not be a trialist for a lower age group
- Players who are currently serving suspension from Tri-County or Alberta Soccer are ineligible as trialists.
