## Rule of Two

The Rule of Two states that there should be at least two adults and two children present at all times, in every situation, including:

- Closed doors meetings
- Watching tape with teams or athletes
- Travel
- Training environments (on the field, locker room etc)



## 24 Hour Rule

Parents/guardians should not confront a coach, team or league official to discuss any 'negative" game or practice situation with the coaching and Board of Directors until at least 24 hours has passed from the completion of the game or practice.






#### Communication Flowchart

#### Respect in Sport - 24 Hour Rule

It is imperative that we RESPECT the game and the process. Understandably, there will be times when we may be frustrated or upset. Wait at least 24 hours before addressing your concerns to ensure you are using a level head.

# Box/Arena Times

#### **Game Times**

All games and indoor practice times are scheduled and posted by the CDLA. The Axemen Lacrosse club submits the tournaments each team is offered to the CDLA and they will do their best as not to schedule league games on the same days. If you book a tournament on your own, it is the team's responsibility to notify the CDLA of any games you will be missing

#### **Exhibition Games**

If you would like to arrange an exhibition game for your team, you should contact the Facility who will advise you of any available floor time. Your team will cover the cost of the floor time. # Player Movement And Affiliation

#### **New Players**

Only registered players may participate in Axemen team games and practices. Athletes not yet registered are not allowed on the floor until officially registered by the Axemen Registrar.


Coaches and other team officials cannot accept registrations.
