


President's Report

Grow the game

We need more facilities!

Acute shortage of indoor space is affecting everyone in YYC

- Soccer and Lacrosse are the biggest users of indoor space (Calgary Soccer Centre) year round. Both sports are experiencing significant growth and this will only make things tougher in the near future.
- Lack of alternatives makes the Soccer Centre the primary facility both sports look at for programming

Impacts to programming that lack of floors has

- Shortening of game times
- Fewer games
- Shared floor practices
- Season could extend well into July



Key events for 2025


Timberfest 2025
