

BAHA RULE OF TWO POLICY

Throughout the hockey season appropriate player supervision should be a priority for all BAHA teams and staff. As such, Beaumont Amateur Hockey Association is implementing the “The Rule Of Two” policy that is mentioned throughout Hockey Canada HCSP material and Hockey Canada Coaching Materials. This list describes the “The Rule Of Two”

Supervisory Responsibilities

- Dressing Room
Players should be supervised at all times. A lone personnel member should never be in the dressing room with players at any time, especially when players are showering or changing: two (2) adults are to be present in the dressing room together.
- Teams with Female Players
Recommend that when using the “The Rule Of Two” with female hockey teams, there shall be 2 female supervisors with the players whenever possible. If two female supervisors is not possible there may be one male (1) male and one (1) female supervisor. At least one (1) female must be present at all times.
