For any teams that play against other clubs (ex: Argyle, Yarmouth, etc) or will be participating against other clubs in a tournament (even a year end tournament) these are the requirements:

Grassroots Stream* (U13 and U15+ as well as any U11 teams that consider doing tournaments outside of BLAST)

- 2. NCCP Make Ethical Decisions Module and/or Online Evaluation
- 3. Respect in Sport Activity Leader Program
- 4. NCCP Making Headway Module
- 5. NCCP Emergency Action Planning Module
- 6. NCCP Rule of Two Module
- 7. Fundamentals, Learn to Train or Soccer for Life Online Training Module and Practical workshop
