TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- 4 Games Guaranteed
- 13U All Players Must Be Born In 2006 Or Younger

BAT REGULATIONS:

- -10 Max Differential And 2 5/8 Max Barrel Size
- · No Big Barrel

PLAYING RULES: Modified Baseball Alberta Rules

- · Leadoffs allowed
- BREAKING BALLS ALLOWED
- Limited Substitution
- 7 inning games
- 48 ft mound, 70 ft basepaths
- Baseball Alberta Pitching/Catching Rule: Once you enter agame as a pitcher, you are ineligible to be the catcher for the remainder of the day.

SCOREKEEPING:

For pool play, Home team provides Scorekeeper and visiting team provides Pitch Counter. For playoff round, tournament will provide both.

GAMES ENDING IN A TIE:

- International Tie Breaker Rules Previous 2 batters are at 1st and 2nd Base respectively, no outs
- Will continue playing until time limit is reached or a winner is determined. Games that are tied after the 2 & 1/2 hour limit will end in a tie for round robin only. Playoff games will be played until there is a winner.

ROUND ROBIN TIE BREAKER:

1st Tie Breaker is Head to Head. 2nd Tie Breaker is defensive runs formula [Runs Against/Defensive Outs] between tied teams. 3rd Tie Breaker is defensive runs formula over all games played. 4th Tie Breaker is Coin Flip.

MERCY RULE:

10 runs after 5 innings, or 41/2 if the home team is ahead

LINEUP RULES: Modified Baseball Alberta Fair Play Rules

- Each player on lineup card must get 1 AB and 3 defensive outs
- EH allowed
- A starting pitcher will not be subject to fair play rules for the other game of the day for that particular team. (ie. Pitcher A
 that starts Game 1 can be listed on the lineup card for Game 2 but is not required to play defensively or receive an AB
 and vice versa)

PITCHING RULES:

- Pitch counts are for the entire day. Eg. If a team plays 2 games in 1
 day and a pitcher is used in both games, his pitch total for the day
 will be calculated as the sum of pitches from both games.
- Pitchers may finish the batter if the rest threshold has been hit and the manager notifies the umpire and scorekeeper
- Pitch counts do not roll over to the next day. Eg. A pitcher who throws 25 pitches on Day 1 can return and throw 25 pitches on day 2 and will not require rest on Day 3.

PITCH COUNT (single day)	REST REQUIRED
0 - 25	none
26 - 50	1 day
50 - 75	2 days
76 - 95	no more eligibility

SPEED UP RULES:

- 2nd out in the inning can be a courtesy runner for the catcher with 2 outs.
- No new inning after 2 1/2 hours.

PROTESTING & DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

All protests will be decided by the tournament officials present at the time of the protest and all decisions will be final. 1st ejections of the tournament for players and coaches will not result in game suspension, 2nd ejections will result in suspension from the rest of the tournament.
