These serve to remind our patrons that drinking in the parking lots is not allowed and everyone must adhere to the by law. We appreciate your compliance to ensure everyone’s safety.

Burlington residents and visitors can now enjoy smoke-free outdoor spaces. Outdoor public places on municipal and regional properties are smoke-free as of April 1, 2014. City Council amended bylaw 35-176 in November 2013 to ban smoking in city parks and recreation facilities. There have also been changes made to the Smoke Free Ontario Act to further protect children and youth from the dangers of smoking. Learn more at Ontario.ca/smokefree
