- The HL Committee also took into consideration if the players are on a HL Select team and distributed those players throughout the divisions
- The HL Committee has done our best to accommodate requests and ensuring that all the above have been taken into consideration when creating teams



House League Select

- 2nd year of the program since it's return
- 4 teams (9U, 11U, 13U and 15U)
- Tryouts happen in February and team selection happens early March
- In order to play on a HL Select team, you must be on a House League team as well
- HL Select is a tournament team only



Resources for Coaches

- All coaches have the opportunity to use the practice plans and drills on the website or app.
- This is a useful tool to help even the most experienced coach or the new to coaching volunteer.

- We always need more umpires please have anyone interested contact Dave Phillips at <u>umpireinchief@baseballburlington.com</u>.


