



## MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING

### PURPOSE

Baseball Manitoba is committed to creating a positive sport environment. Baseball Manitoba reserves the right to grant access to all aspects of Baseball Manitoba's operations, to only those deemed to be "In Good Standing" with the associations.

### POLICY STATEMENT

All members are required to be "In Good Standing" in order to be active participants in all Baseball Manitoba programs and events.

### DEFINITIONS:

Association- refers to any of the following:

- Community based Association
- League Association
- Provincial Baseball Association (Baseball Manitoba)
- Western Baseball Association (Western Canada Baseball Association)
- National Baseball Association (Baseball Canada)

### SCOPE & APPLICATION:

1. A member shall be deemed to be "***In Good Standing***" provided they have:
  - 1.1. Paid membership dues, registration fees or payments as set out by the Association
  - 1.2. The member has complied with the Constitution, By-Laws and Policies of the Association
  - 1.3. The member is not subject to a disciplinary investigation or action of any Association
  - 1.4. The member has not voluntarily withdrawn from membership
  - 1.5. The member has not been expelled or suspended from the Association
2. Failing any of the criteria set out in 1, may put the member into "***Not In Good Standing***".
3. A member who is deemed to be "***Not In Good Standing***" is ineligible for any benefits which members are entitled to, including but not limited to the following:
  - 3.1. Ineligible to register to compete, coach or umpire
  - 3.2. Ineligible to compete, coach, umpire
  - 3.3. Ineligible to take part in any programs, attend any player, coach or umpire clinics
  - 3.4. Ineligible to attend Association meetings
  - 3.5. Ineligible to receive any funding
  - 3.6. Is not covered by Baseball Manitoba Insurance
4. Associations must notify Baseball Manitoba immediately, upon deeming a member to be "Not In Good Standing".
