## **UMPIRE ABUSE POLICY**

- 1. That all instances where a report is filed pertaining to physical abuse of an umpire, that report will be filed directly to the M.B.A. office within 24 hours (mailed, faxed, delivered).
- 2. The M.B.A. Executive Director is to direct the report to the M.B.A. Vice-President of Umpires and to the M.B.A. Vice-President of Competitions immediately.
- Depending on the report; if a disciplinary hearing is necessary, it must take place within four days of the receipt of the report by the M.B.A. Office; and the Hearing Committee shall be convened.
- 4. The Hearing Committee shall consist of: Vice-President of Competitions, Vice-President of Umpires, the Executive Director; any two members of the Competition Committee.
- 5. After the Hearing the abuser must be informed immediately of the Hearing Committee's decision by phone and confirmed in writing.
- 6. The team and league involved are to be advised accordingly.
- 7. If the M.B.A. Executive Director and Technical Director, upon receipt of the report, believe the actions are serious enough to warrant a suspension before the Hearing Committee is convened, they may do so by phoning the involved parties (abuser, team, league) immediately, along with the Vice-President of Umpires and the Vice-President of Competitions.
- 8. Any suspensions will be honoured by all M.B.A. League Members.
