## **LEVELS: AAA VS AA**

# COMMITMENT

Teams can request different schedule types for the season when registering! A full schedule may be between 20-24 games, while a half schedule is I0-I4 games. Other schedule requests can be made in the Notes section! Games can be scheduled across the province, but efforts are made to minimize long travel and to regionalize games as much as possible.

#### **KEY DATES FOR 2025**

Bluenose League Registration deadline is May I2th for I7U Girls, and May I9th for I2U and I4U Girls! League play kicks off on May 26th for I7U, and June 2nd for I2U and I4U! Schedules run until the Provincial Championship for the division.

Provincial Championships take place August 15th -17th (I4U), August 22nd - 24th (I2U), and August 29th - 3Ist (I7U). Hosts and schedules are released in July!
