



2026 BPEI 15UAAA Rules

Player Eligibility

- Players must be 15U-aged, meaning they turn 14 or 15 years old during the 2026 calendar year.
-

Roster Rules

- All affiliate players (APs) must be listed as AP players on the roster in RAMP.
-

Affiliate Player Rules

- A player may be called up to one (1) higher division team within their age category or an older age category for four (4) games within their own minor baseball association/zone.
 - The player must be marked as an Affiliate Player (AP) on the lineup card and listed on the roster in the RAMP system.
 - After the fourth game at a higher level, the player is no longer eligible to be used as an AP.
 - In any circumstance where an ineligible player is used as an AP, the offending coach(es) will be subject to discipline by the Baseball PEI Board of Directors.
 - In addition to regular season games, an AP may participate in Provincial Championship games provided they have not exceeded four (4) regular season games.
 - If the AP has played in four (4) regular season games, they may participate in up to two (2) Provincial Championship games.
 - If the AP has played in three (3) or fewer regular season games, they may participate in up to three (3) Provincial Championship games.
 - An AP may not participate in more than three (3) Provincial Championship games.
 - Exhibition games, including tournaments not operated by Baseball PEI, do not count toward the four (4) games a player is permitted to affiliate.

Game Structure

- Baseball Canada 15U rules will apply except for the following adaptations:



- There will be no time limit for regular season games. This may be reviewed during the season if concerns arise.

Equipment

- All games will be played using Rawlings 80cc baseballs (or better).
 - **Footwear:**
 - Both steel and rubber cleats are permitted.
 - **Bat Rules for 15U:**
 - Bat rules will follow Baseball Canada regulations.

Batting & Lineup

- During the regular season, all players will bat and there may be unlimited defensive substitutions.
 - At Provincial Championships:
 - Only nine (9) players will bat, or
 - Ten (10) players if using the Extra Hitter (EH) rule.
 - The re-entry rule will apply.

Defensive Substitution

- Unlimited defensive substitutions are permitted during regular season play.
-

Coach & Bench Personnel Requirements

- All coaches and on-field bench personnel in the AAA division are required to wear a full baseball uniform while participating in games on the field of play.
 - Failure to comply may result in BPEI issuing fines to the team and/or the association.

Other Game Rules

- All games played on Prince Edward Island will use the Baseball PEI Pitch Count Rules.
 - Baseball PEI Non-Confrontation Rules will be in effect for all games.

Provincial Championship Eligibility

- Teams must complete their schedule in order to be eligible for the Provincial Championships.

Post-Game Responsibilities

- After each game (deadline: 12:00 PM noon the following day), the home team must record the following on their team webpage:
 - Game score
 - Names of pitchers for both teams
 - Pitch counts of all pitchers
 - Names of both umpires
- Failure to do so will result in a fine.
- The home team shall provide:
 - Two (2) brand new baseballs for each game
 - Two (2) good “second” balls for each game.
