Baseball PEI Championship Format for 3,4,5,6 and 8 Team Draws

Draws and schedules found in this appendix are subject to change by the Baseball PEI Board of Directors. These are guidelines may be changed for reasons such as availability of umpires, fields, or lights on the field etc.

FORMATS

Two-Team Draw

- The format shall be the best-of-three series with Games #1 and #2 played on Day #1 in one location, and Game #3 played on Day #2 at the other location. The higher seeded team will have choice of hosting and being the home team on day 1 or 2.

Two-team best-of-three series schedule (the times are suggested; they are subject to change by Baseball PEI due to various reasons. One field is necessary for this format):

Day #1

Game # 1: 1 am

Game # 2: 4 pm

Day #2

Game # 3 (if necessary): 2 pm

Three-Team Draw

- All three-team draws shall be a double round-robin format played over one weekend. "A" will be the host team, "B" will be the second-closest team in terms of the location of the primary field, and "C" will be the team that must travel the farthest to get to the primary field.
 - If one team is undefeated during the round robin it shall be declared the champion. Otherwise, the first and second place teams will play a single Championship game. Should all three teams finish the round robin with 2-2 records, the tie-breaking formula shall be used to determine 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. In that scenario, 1st-place will advance to the Championship game, while 2nd and 3rd place plays a tie-breaker game. Winner of tie-breaker game will advance to play the first-place team in a single Championship Game.
 - The home first team listed in the round-robin will have the home game. If one team finishes the round robin with a better record, they will have choice of home in the Championship game. If both teams finished the round robin at 3-1 or both were 2-2 then there will be a coin toss for choice of home game.

Four-Team Draw - 1 Team Advancing to Nationals/Atlantics Events

- Four-team draws shall be a single round-robin format played over one weekend. "A" will be the host team, "B" will be the second-closest team (in terms of the location of the primary field), "C" will be the third-closest team and "D" will be the team that must travel the farthest to get to the primary field. A coin flip prior to each round-robin game will determine the home team for that game.

- Four-team draw determining one team attending a Baseball Atlantic or Baseball Canada Championship.

1. 3-0 and other teams are 1-2; 3-0 team will be **declared Champion with no Championship Game.**

2. 3-0 vs 2-1 the 2-1 team will have to defeat the 3-0 team twice.

3. Three teams tied at 2-1 after the round robin, the first-place team shall be determined using the tie-breaking procedure. The second place and third-place teams shall play a tie-breaking game with the winner advancing to play a single Championship game against the first-place team.

- Higher-placing team under the tie-breaking procedure shall be the home team in each tie-breaking or first Championship game. If a second Championship game is required, a coin flip will determine the home team.

- A coin flip will be used to determine the home team for all round-robin games and if there is a second Championship game. The higher-ranked team will have a choice of a home game in the (first) Championship game.

Four-Team Draw (With 2 teams advancing to an Atlantic/National Event)

- Any four-team draw determining two teams attending a Baseball Atlantic or Baseball Canada Championship, upon completion of the round-robin, teams finishing 2nd and 3rd place will play in a semi-final with the winner of that game advancing to the final to play the team finishing in 1st-place.

Day #4

2nd vs 3rd Semi-final: 10 am

Championship game: 1 pm

- If 3 Teams go 1-2, we will use the Tie Breaking rules to determine 2nd and 3rd,. They will play to determine who will be PEI 2. The 4th place team will be eliminated and 3-0 Team will be PEI 1.

Possible Outcome (4 Teams with 2 Team Advancing) #1

3 – 0 * Advances to Final; with option of Home Game in Finals.
2 – 1 * Places 2nd and Advances to Semi-Finals with option of Home Game.
1 – 2 * Places 3rd and Advances to Semi-Finals
0 – 3 Eliminated

Possible Outcome (4 Teams with 2 Team Advancing) #2

3 – 0 * Wins Tournament as all other Teams have 2 Losses – PEI #1
1 – 2 * Placed 2nd from Tie Breaking Rules and Advances to Semi-Finals with choice of Home game.
1 – 2 * Placed 3rd from Tie Breaking Rules and Advances to Semi-Finals

- 1 – 2 * Placed 3rd from Tie Breaking Rules and Advances to Semi-Finals
- 1 – 2 Eliminated

Five-Team Draw - 1 Team Advancing to Nationals/Atlantics Events

- Five-team shall be a single round-robin format played over one weekend. “A” will be the host team, Teams E will be the last place team based on seeding. Out of the 3 remaining team the closest in distance to the field will be Team B, the next closest Team C and the furthest Team D.
- Upon completion of the round-robin, the 1st and 2nd place teams shall advance to the championship game. However, if the first-place team goes undefeated in the round-robin and all other teams have at least two losses, the first-place team shall be **declared champion**, and **no championship game** will be required.
- At the 13U “AAA” level, where two representatives of PEI go to the Baseball Canada National Atlantic 13U Championships, if a team goes undefeated, it will be PEI #1. If three teams have a 2-2 record, the tie breaking procedure will be used to determine second and third place. They will play a one-game playoff to be played at the time the Championship game is scheduled – to determine who will represent PEI as PEI #2.
- Only If the first-place team has a record of 4-0 and the second-place team has a record of 3-1, does the second-place team must defeat the first-place team twice in order to win the championship (No team can be eliminated unless they have two losses under this format) and two games shall be played if necessary.
- If three teams are tied with a record of 3-1, the tie-breaking procedure will be used to determine the first, second, and third place teams. The first-place team will go directly to the Championship game, while the second and third place teams will have to play a tie-breaking game with the winner advancing to the Championship game.
- The higher placing team under the tie-breaking procedure shall be the home team in each tie-breaking or first Championship game. If a 2nd Championship game is required, a coin flip will determine the home team.
- There will be no coin flip for any games except a second Championship game, if necessary. The first team listed on schedule will have the home game in the round robin. The higher-ranked team will have a choice of a home game in the (first) Championship or Tie Breaking games.

Five-Team Draw (With 2 teams advancing to an Atlantic Event)

- Any five-team draw determining two teams attending a Baseball Atlantic Championship, upon completion of the round-robin, teams finishing 2nd and 3rd place will play in a semi-final with the winner of that game advancing to the final to play the team finishing in 1st-place.

2nd vs 3rd Semi-final: 10 am

Championship game: 1 pm

Possible Outcome (5 Teams with 2 Team Advancing) #1

4 – 0 * Advances to Final; with option of Home Game in Finals.

3 – 1 * Places 2nd and Advances to Semi-Finals with option of Home Game.

2 – 2 * Places 3rd and Advances to Semi-Finals

All other Teams have at least 2 Losses and are Eliminated.

Possible Outcome (5 Teams with 2 Team Advancing) #2

4 – 0 * Advances to Final; with option of Home Game in Finals.

3 – 1 * Advances to Finals as all other Teams have 3 Losses.

All other Teams have at least 3 Losses and are Eliminated (No Semi-Final)

Possible Outcome (5 Teams with 2 Team Advancing) #3

4 – 0 * Wins Tournament as all other Teams have 2 Losses – PEI #1 (No Finals)

2 – 2 * Placed 2nd from Tie Breaking Rules and Advances to Semi-Finals with choice of Home game.

2 – 2 * Placed 3rd from Tie Breaking Rules and Advances to Semi-Finals

2 – 2 Eliminated

0 – 4 Eliminated

Possible Outcome (5 Teams with 2 Team Advancing) #4

4 – 0 * Wins Tournament as all other Teams have 2 Losses – PEI #1 (No Finals)

2 – 2 * Placed 2nd from Tie Breaking Rules and Advances to Semi-Finals with choice of Home game.

2 – 2 * Placed 3rd from Tie Breaking Rules and Advances to Semi-Finals

All other Teams have at least 3 Losses and are Eliminated.

Six-Team Draw

- All six-team single-weekend draws shall be scheduled as a two-pool format. Each team will be seeded by the League Standings.
- Pool “A” shall consist of teams #1, #4 and #6
- Pool “B” shall consist of teams #2, #3 and #5.
- Each team will play a single round-robin within their pool. The top team from each pool will advance to the semi-final. Second place in each pool will play the third-place team in the other pool in the quarterfinals, with the winners of the quarter-finals advancing to the semifinals (with the top-ranked team – based on the tie-breaking priorities – playing the lowest-ranked remaining team, and the second-ranked team playing the second-lowest ranked team).
- The winners of the semi-final games will advance to the Final.
- If records are identical after completion of pool play, the tie-breaking procedure will be used to determine rank.
- The only game in which there will be a coin flip to determine who has a choice of home game is the Final.
- The first Team listed on the schedule in the round-robin will have the home game, and all quarter- and semi-final games will feature the higher-ranked team having the choice to be the home team.

Two fields are necessary on Day 1 for this format (they don’t have to be at the same location):

- All eight-team draws shall be scheduled as a two-pool format. Each team will be seeded 1 through 8 based on the League Standings.

Pool "A" teams #1, #3, #6 and #8 Pool "B" teams #2, #4, #5 and #7.

Each team will play a single round-robin within their own pool. Upon completion of pool play, the top two teams from each pool will advance to the semi-finals with 2 "B" playing 1 "A" and 2 "A" playing 1 "B", with the two winners advancing to the Championship game.

- A coin flip will determine home team in all round-robin games and in the Championship Game.
- Higher-seeded team in the semi-finals will have the choice of being the home team.
- Suggested eight-team single-weekend draw #1 (the times are suggested; they are subject to change by Baseball PEI due to various reasons. Two fields are necessary for this format):

Tie Breaking Procedures

Tie-Breaking Procedure for Seeding within 1 Division

- Should ties occur between the teams, standings will be decided according to the following priorities below.
- When a multiple tie occurs and is only partially resolved, the remaining ties will be resolved by continuing with the remaining tie-breaking priorities until all priorities have been exhausted. Then and only then, will the remaining tied teams return to priority number 1 and proceed through the order again. **Note Different than Provincials and Tournaments as we do not keep track of defensive and offensive innings played during the regular season so too hard to verify.**
 - 1) The team with the best won-lost record in the game(s) between or among the tied teams will place higher in the standings.
 - 2) If the tie persists, the placement of teams will be dictated by the ratio of runs against per games between or among the originally tied teams.
 - 3) If the tie persists, the placement of teams will be dictated by the ratio of runs scored per game between or among the original tied teams.
 - 4) If the tie persists, the team having the best won-lost record in games played versus the highest placed team not in the tie, followed by comparison against the next highest placed team, etc. will place higher in the standings.
 - 5) If the tie persists, the team with the best defensive ratio of defensive runs per game using all games will place higher in the standings.
 - 6) If the tie persists, the team with the best offensive ratio of offensive runs per offensive innings in all games will place higher in the standings.

Example:

o Northside, Cardigan, and Souris are all tied after the completion of the Round Robin portion of the tournament.

- Priority #1

Northside defeated Cardigan 6-3

Souris defeated Northside 6-4

Cardigan defeated Souris 10-8

(No tie resolved, move to next priority)

- Priority #2

Northside - 9 runs against in 2 games $(9/2) = 4.50$

Cardigan - 14 runs against in 2 games $(14/2) = 7.00$

Souris - 14 runs against in 2 games $(14/2) = 7.000$

(Northside emerges from the tie but Cardigan and Souris remain tied and must move to next priority)



- Priority #3

Cardigan - 13 runs for in 2 games (13/2) = 6.50

Souris - 14 runs for in 2 games (14/2) = 7.00

(Souris emerges from the tie)

Tie Breaking for Multi-Division League

- Ties between Teams within the same Division will use the 1 Division rules above.
- However, ties between Teams in different Division will use these as they don't play against the same teams.
 1. Placement within your division all 1st Place Teams will be seeded first; then all of the 2nd Place Teams and so on.
 2. Since depending on Number of Teams in the League some Divisions could play 2 more games than other Divisions, we will use winning % instead of points to break ties.
 3. If the tie persists, the team with the best defensive ratio of defensive runs per game using all games will place higher in the standings.
 4. If the tie persists, the team with the best offensive ratio of offensive runs per offensive innings in all games will place higher in the standings.
 5. Coin Toss if everything above is still tied.

This information in conjunction with the league standings will be determine the seeding for the Eliminations. The decision of the ED/League Director will not be appealable.
