THE SASKATCHEWAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Recipient of the 2019 Scholarship Award was Brooklyn Shaw, Air Ronge, Saskatchewan. Brooklyn's love of baseball while playing in the Battlefords Minor League for three [3] years. As a child of RCMP parents she moved to Swift Current in 2010 and continued in the Minor Leagues there. She chose to play baseball even though she was the only girl on the team most years. Moving to LaRonge on 2012, Brooklyn was able to continue playing baseball on the newly formed minor league in that community.

Brooklyn has been a member of the Saskatchewan girls baseball teams competing with the 13 and under, then the 16 and under and the 21 and under. She travelled from La Ronge to Saskatoon during the winter to continue training with the women's team. She was on the training roster for summer 2019.

Brooklyn has transferred her love of the game to volunteering in the community. She has been assistant coach with LaRonge Minor Ball for the past three [3] seasons and head coach in 2019. As well, Brooklyn assisted with the 11 and under Provincial team.

Brooklyn was a grade 12 student at Churchill High School at LaRonge, maintaining a 90% average, and has been accepted at the University of Regina into a Bachelor of Science program with a focus on pre-dentistry.


