2023 HIGHLIGHTS

- ☐ Registration just over 1,000; approximately 20% females
- ☐ Hosted the 4th Annual Mike Buist Classic with 50+ teams
- ☐ Increased the number of fields available
- Hosted a full suite of school tournaments with a big increase in registration





2023 HIGHLIGHTS

- Revamped 18U all star play
 - Picked teams earlier as part of regular all star team selections
 - Added an A team
 - Introduced metro league play for AA and A teams
- ☐ Hosted 13UAA, 15UA, 16U, 18UA provincials and 18UAA qualifier







2023 HIGHLIGHTS

- ☐ Had two A teams in 11U, 13U, and 15U
- Won 6 provincial championships
- Restructured committees to add representation from outside Board
- Invested in new training equipment including a pitching machine







2023 CHALLENGES

- Delivering expanded and new programming with no staff increases
- Increased demands on staffslowed response times on occasion
- Increased demands meant certain things didn't happen as quickly as usual (e.g. processing refunds and payments, responding to inquiries)





2023 CHALLENGES

- Registration getting close to capacity given existing facility availability
- Increasing costs due to inflation and minimum wage increases
- Difficulty obtaining league sponsors
- Moving forward infrastructure projects





2024 PRIORITIES

- ☐ Transition to a new Executive Director
- Reviewing current organizational structure
 - ✓ ED roles & responsibilities
 - ✓ Staffing types and #s
 - Committee structure
- ☐ Reviewing existing programming including HPP, school tournaments





2024 PRIORITIES

- ☐ Complete installation of score board at EHF/LSP
- ☐ Install lights at batting cages and parking lot at St. Pat's with SJABA
- Provide more opportunities for coach and umpire development





2024 PRIORITIES

- ☐ Increase corporate sponsorships and sponsor engagement/recognition
- ☐ Strengthen existing programming
- Enhance engagement with parents, coaches, managers, community partners


