# Guide For Specialty Camps

A lot of things have changed this year and you will notice some changes at PSA. Here's how we can ensure we have fun playing baseball while still staying safe and protecting ourselves.



### Before Arriving

- You will need to wash your hands before arriving at the facility
- Players should not attend if they are sick. We advise that families should self-administer the NLESD questionnaire before attending a session
- Players that must isolate due to Public Health guidance are not permitted to attend.



### Upon Arrival

- Parents must drop players off at the entrance
- Parents are not permitted inside the facility
- Players must use the hand sanitizer provided when they enter and exit the facility or when they leave the turf
- Masks must be worn when entering, exiting and waiting in the lobby. We encourage mask usage as much as possible on the turf!



### Rules and Regulations

- Players must abide by posted health and safety regulations
- Players cannot come to the field if they feel unwell
- Masks should be worn during instruction and light activity where appropriate.
- Physical distancing MUST be maintained at all times
- Staff will need to show their Vax pass upon entry but players do not



### Facilities

- Players are requested to limit the amount of items they bring to the facility
- Players should bring their own helmets and bats if available
- Players should come dressed with sneakers/cleats on



### Things to Remember

- Parents must drop off players no earlier than 5 minutes before a session and pick them up no later than 5 minutes at the conclusion of a session.
- Ensure that you continue to use hand sanitizer throughout the session
- Staff are working to ensure everyone stays safe. Players MUST abide by all instructions given to them throughout the session.
