


St. John's Minor Baseball: COVID-19 Spectator Zones

- Airport Heights: Spectators can use the bleachers near the playground and sit behind the outfield fence. They cannot use the bleachers down the 1st and 3rd base lines. Spectators are not permitted behind the backstop or down the lines.
- Bannerman Park: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Conway Glenn: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Kelly's Brook: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Kitty Gaul: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Kilbride: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Little St. Pat's (Edgar Hartery): Spectators can sit in the bleachers in the outfield and around the outfield but are not permitted down the backstop or 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Shea Heights: Spectators can sit around the outfield but are not permitted down the backstop or 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Terra Nova: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Virginia Park: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Wyatt Park: Spectators can sit behind the backstop and outfield fence but are not permitted down the 1st and 3rd base lines.
- Wishingwell: Spectators are free to move around and use bleachers for Rally Cap sessions. For games in other divisions, spectators must remain on bleachers or behind the outfield fence
