

## **Assistant Coach, Team Alberta North Provincial Team - Boys**

**Contract Term:** September 2025 – March 31, 2026

**Compensation:** \$1,000 upon successful completion of all season requirements

**Reports to:** Head Coach, Team Alberta North Provincial Team; Technical Director/Manager of Coach Education & High-Performance Program Lead – Men's

### **About the Program**

Every two years, Team Alberta North brings together top basketball athletes from communities above the 55th parallel to compete at the Arctic Winter Games. The program is dedicated to athlete identification and development for northern Alberta residents, and many alumni go on to excel at higher levels, including post-secondary and professional basketball. Coaches and athletes must reside above the 55th parallel in Alberta to be eligible.

This contract position runs from September and concludes after the Arctic Winter Games tournament and related administrative duties (approximately March 31, 2026).

### **What We're Looking For**

We're seeking a dedicated and passionate Assistant Coach to support the Head Coach in all aspects of the 2025–26 Team Alberta North program. As Assistant Coach, you will play a crucial supporting role in talent selection, training, and competition, helping prepare Team Alberta North for the 2026 Arctic Winter Games.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Support the Head Coach in player identification and selection at the Combine, camps, and tryouts.
- Assist with planning, delivering, and monitoring training sessions.
- Provide mentorship and support to athletes in a safe, inclusive, and positive environment.
- Foster open, regular communication with athletes, parents, and ABA staff, as directed by the Head Coach.
- Model exemplary conduct in line with ABA's Code of Conduct and Equity policies.
- Support the Head Coach in managing operations, communications, reporting, and budget.
- Participate fully in all team activities and meetings required by the Head Coach or ABA.
- Participate as a coaching staff member of the AB ID athlete development program or the regional ABA CB Academy program

## **Requirements**

- Coaching experience at the club, high school, collegiate, U Sports, or Provincial/National Team level.
- Strong understanding of basketball technical and tactical concepts, and athlete development.
- Commitment to the “Train to Compete” NCCP Certification pathway (minimum ‘In Training’ status required).
- Compete Pathway:
  - Year one with Team Alberta: In Training
  - Year two with Team Alberta: Trained
  - Year three with Team Alberta: Certified
- Current L2T or T2T certification will be considered in lieu of progress in the T2C pathway.
- Current Safe Sport training and ABA Membership in good standing.
- Valid Police/Vulnerable Sector Check (to be submitted via RAMP system with application).
- Reliable transportation and willingness to travel within Alberta.
- Strong communication, organizational, and teamwork skills.
