We seek experienced and passionate Head Coaches for our 2026 14U Boys Zone Teams. You'll lead our team through talent selection, training, and competition at the 2026 Alberta Summer Games.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead player identification and selection at the Combine, camps, and tryouts
- Plan, deliver, and monitor training
- Mentor coaching staff and players in a safe, inclusive, and positive environment
- Regular, open communication with athletes, parents, and ABA staff
- Model exemplary conduct in line with ABA's Code of Conduct and Equity policies
- Manage program operations, communications, reporting, and budget

Requirements

- Experience coaching at club, collegiate, junior high or high school setting
- Strong knowledge of basketball technical/tactical aspects and athlete development

NCCP Certification Requirement:

- One coach in each zone must minimally meet one of the following under the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP):
 - Certified - Learn to Train (L2T)
 - In Training - Train to Compete (T2C)
- Additional coach must minimally meet one of the following under NCCP:

- Trained - Learn to Train (L2T)
 - In Training - Train to Compete (T2C)
- All coaches must also have completed the NCCP Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation.
- Valid Police/Vulnerable Sector Check (submit with application via RAMP system)
- Member of ABA in good standing
- Reliable transportation and willingness to travel within Alberta
- Strong leadership, communication, and organizational skills
