



# RESTRICTION EXEMPTION PROGRAM

## EFFECTIVE, FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 24, 2021

As per the Province of Alberta's Restriction Exemption Program, everyone ages 12 and older accessing the building are required to provide proof of vaccination, proof of a negative PCR/Rapid Test, or documentation of a medical exemption to enter Edge School, for non-academic activity. Partial vaccination (one dose) will be accepted until Oct. 25, 2021, if received two weeks prior to the day of entry. After Oct. 25, 2021, full vaccination (two doses) will be required two weeks prior to the day of entry.

### YOUTH SPORT EXEMPTION

As per Alberta's Chief Medical Officer of Health's direction regarding **youth sport** (under 18 years of age), Edge School will not be requiring proof of vaccination to participate in youth sport. This exemption applies only to sport participation. To enter any other part of Edge School or to spectate, proof of vaccination, a negative COVID test result or medical exemption will be required.

### ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF VACCINATION

- Valid photo identification that matches the vaccine record (only required for adults 18 and over)
- Valid paper or digital vaccine record that shows name, vaccine type and date of administration:
  - From Sept. 20 to Oct. 25: proof of partial vaccination (one dose) is considered acceptable as long as the dose was given two weeks before the time of entry.
  - After Oct. 25: proof of full vaccination (two doses) is required.

### ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF NEGATIVE COVID TEST RESULT

- Tests must be privately-paid, Health Canada approved rapid antigen, rapid PCR or lab-based PCR test completed within the previous 72 hours.
  - Valid test results should be a written or printed copy that clearly outlines the type of test, time of sample collection, clear indication of a negative result, and laboratory that completed the test, if applicable.
  - Photos of a rapid test result taken offsite is not sufficient.
  - Do not bring completed self-tests or rapid tests to businesses due to communicable disease risk.

### ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF MEDICAL EXEMPTION

- A valid medical exemption is the original signed letter from a physician or nurse practitioner that includes:
  - Person's name that matches their identification.
  - Physician's or nurse practitioner's complete information, including:
    - name, phone number, contact information, professional registration number and signature.
    - statement that there is a medical reason for not being fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
    - duration that the exemption is valid.

### FACILITY RULES

- Everyone must wear a mask throughout Edge School, except when actively participating in sport.
- Physical distancing is encouraged throughout Edge School.
- All participants and spectators must enter through the main entrance and check-in upon entry.
- No spectators permitted for adult sport activities/rentals.
