UPDATE - February 10, 2022

Effective immediately:

- Visitors will no longer require proof of vaccination/QR codes for entry into University of Alberta sport and recreation facilities.
- All users and spectators must screen for COVID-19 symptoms. If you do have any symptoms, please stay home until you are symptom free.
- Spectator access will be limited to 1 spectator per participant at this time, total occupancy will be limited to 50% of fire code for all events (for areas with greater than 500 person capacity).
- Food and beverage may be consumed in our facilities while seated.

Face coverings must be worn at all times in indoor facilities except while engaged in high intensity physical activity.

Eligibility Criteria:

All teams/community programs who wish to participate in the 2022 Youth Provincial 'A' and 'Championships and 'C/D' Tournament must adhere to the following:

- PLEASE NOTE: It is the intent of this technical package to encourage interest and participation for youth basketball teams from across the province in a safe, fair, competitive, and inclusive environment.
- All participating athletes and coaches at the 2022 Youth Provincials are required to have an ABA membership for the 2021/2022 ABA Membership Year. Please contact the ABA office if you have any questions regarding individual membership.
- All players must meet the age criteria outlined in this package; all rosters to be verified prior to competition.
- First preference to be given to declarations submitted from community/grassroots organizations.



- Alberta Basketball will confirm teams for Youth Provincials once divisions are full or by Friday, March 4, 2022, whichever comes first. Qualifying teams will be contacted by phone or by email to confirm. Non confirmed teams will receive a full refund of their declaration fee.
- If a division has remaining open spots available, the next consideration will go to school and club teams.
- Players may be listed on and participate for only one roster for the duration of the 2022 Youth Provincials.
- In the case of any community that has an existing community/zone-based youth league or association, such as Zone 3 - Calgary or Zone 6 - Edmonton, players will be expected to play on the team from their community/zone and not on another team such as a school or club team. If the player's community/zone team does not declare a team then the player will be eligible to participate on a school or club roster.
- High school players that have played for their Sr. Varsity team during the 2021-2022 season and are still active in ASAA playoffs will not be eligible to participate.
- The host organization will be allotted up to 3 declaration spots in each 'A' and 'B' divisions for each gender. The host organization will be allotted up to 2 declaration spots in the 'C/D' divisions for each gender.
- 'B' division - must be non-'A/Div 1' teams during their season of play, including playoffs. 'B' division teams must qualify for competition as outlined in this package.
- At Provincials, compete at a level equal to or higher than the level played during their season of play. (for example, an 'A' or 'Div1' team can enter only 'A' provincials; a 'B' or 'Div2' team may enter 'B' or 'A' provincials).
- The 'C/D' Division is open to teams that participate at a 'C/D' or 'Div3/4' level of play. The host organization will have a minimum of two (2) spots allocated. All other declarations will be considered on a first-in basis to fill out the remaining two to four (2 - 4) spots; registration will be closed once the division is full. Once closed, all new declarations will be added to a waitlist for available spots.
- The 18U 3X3 Divisions are open declarations to teams that may have participated during the Fall or Winter seasons of league play. All declarations will be considered on a first-in basis; registration will be closed once the division is full. Once closed, all new declarations will be added to a waitlist for available spots.
- Meet all other deadlines and criteria as outlined in this package.

Competition Format:	<p>Guarantee of 3 games. Schedules posted with seeding information by March 8, 2022.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tournament draw formats will be dependent upon the number of participating teams. Divisions of 4, 6 or 8 teams will play a round robin format.

Coaching Requirements:

2022 Youth Provincials - NCCP FUNDamentals is the minimum RECOMMENDED requirement. *Please note, coaching requirements will be reviewed for the 2023 Youth Provincial Championships.

Declaration Deadline: Monday, February 28, 2022, at 4pm

The following must be submitted to Alberta Basketball by the Declaration Deadline:

1. 2022 Alberta Basketball Youth Provincial Championships Team/Association Declaration Online Forms:

2. Registration fee of \$475.00* per team at time of registration.
*18U 3X3 Division registration fee is \$225.00 per team

Roster Deadline: Thursday, March 3rd, 2022 at 12 noon

All final team rosters are to be submitted to Alberta Basketball. ABA may contact the administrator of the league of play for confirmation and validity prior to participation at the Championships. Requests for roster modification must be presented to Alberta Basketball to be reviewed with their league of play for considerations. NO 'A' players may be added to 'B' teams, 'B' players will be permitted to participate on 'A' teams. A player may be registered on only one roster for participation at the 2022 Youth Provincials.

The following must be submitted to Alberta Basketball by the Roster Deadline:

1. Completed 2022 Alberta Basketball Youth Provincial Championships Declaration and Roster Form, one per team. 2022 YP Declaration Here
2. Full payment of declaration fees

Teams/organizations may also be required to provide:

1. Photocopies of Birth Certificates of all players

Please note that failure to submit any of the above by the deadline will be considered an incomplete declaration and may result in teams being replaced in the tournament with teams on the waitlist.

Schedules:

Schedules will be posted on the Alberta Basketball website by March 4, 2022 as a general draw. Once final team confirmation has been determined, the schedules will be updated accordingly with team names prior to the tournament (by Tuesday, March 8, 2022).
