Coaches Checklist

Review rules of practice and game call up

Review that can only AP to one team

Review number and frequency of practice expectations

Review teams costs (tournaments, travel, hotel, etc)

Review player expectations of dressing room rules (parents in room, time dressed before practice)

Can not play in games or practices until roster approved by BMHA/HS via email confirmation.





Guidelines for Parents

Your child can only be affiliated with one team and/or a provincial or carded team in addition to their regular team. Hockey Saskatchewan Bylaw 3.03.01.

Female players may be registered on one female team and/or one minor team roster and/or one provincial playoff team (female or minor) and/or affiliated to one team.

You can contact your division director directly to be placed on an affiliate selection roster.

Being placed on an affiliate section roster does not mean your child will be affiliated to a team.

Before deciding to affiliate with a team, ensure the coach has reviewed with you the coaching checklist above.

Your regular team events are priority over any affiliate team event.

Guidelines for Coaches

Please review Hockey Saskatchewan Handbook for full affiliate rules. Coaches are responsible for tracking any game limitations for their division or league play.

Players should be selected based on their ability to play at the affiliated level.

Affiliate players are to be used in accordance to Hockey Saskatchewan rules "to ensure a game can be played" bylaw 3.01.02. and 6.05.01.

Divisions U7-U13 B division and lower shall not have more than 11 players on their roster including the affiliate player for exhibition or league games if using an affiliate player(s) for that game. Tournaments are exempt.

Affiliate players must be clearly marked on all games dressed with an "AP" listed beside their name on the official game sheet.

Additions and deletions can be made to an Affiliate roster, up to January 10, pending the original roster is submitted to BMHA prior to December 15.

Your Division Director will review any affiliate player submissions are appropriate before forwarding to BMHA.
