SHA Return to Hockey

Frequently Asked Questions

What if our MHA does not determine a COVID-19 Representative and submit the contact information by October 15th to the SHA?

- There will be no games sanctioned for teams in that community until an individual is identified and contact information submitted to the SHA.
- In addition, each team within a MHA must have a person identified as a Team Safety Person who is responsible to be the COVID-19 contact for the MHA COVID-19 Representative.

What if the Mandatory Mask Policy is not enforced within a Community arena?

- The SHA will then not sanction any games nor practices held within that community.
- Disciplinary action may then be taken against the MHA, Team, Team officials and/or players.

Can affiliate players be used to start the season?

- No. At this time affiliates cannot be used as players can only belong to one Mini-League at a time. This will be monitored during the season and in consultation with the Ministry of Health. Affiliates are restricted to their teams only and cannot practice with an affiliate team either.

Are Tournaments allowed?

- No. This again will be monitored during the fall and decisions made further in December

Is travel allowed in and out of the Province for competition?

- No. Travel is restricted solely within the Province.

Can I Coach or Officiate in more than one Mini League?

- Yes. Extra attention must be taken by these individuals regarding PPE and the daily monitoring of their Health using the Provincial Government App.

Are Carded teams for U9 and U11 going to be allowed this season?

- At his time no. However, this will be monitored as the season progresses and in consultation with the Ministry of Health. Decisions will be made in December.



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Will there be SHA Provincial Playoffs this season?

- We certainly hope so! This again will be monitored during the fall and decisions made in December. We will take registrations as per the normal registration deadlines.
- Teams will not be allowed to combine with neighboring communities for Provincials and players will not be able to be taken from other registered League teams for this season.

Who creates the Mini Leagues within the established Leagues?

- Each League is responsible for creating the Mini Leagues within their League and then submitting what has been created to the SHA for approval.
- This allows the SHA to have a record of who are in Mini Leagues and in the event of a COVID breakout, the SHA can advise Sask Health of the teams and the rosters of those teams.

Can a Female player be registered on a Female team and a Co-Ed Minor Team at the same time this season?

- No. Players, male or female can only be part of one Mini League at a time.
- At this time, a player may only be registered on one SHA approved roster.

Is the timeframe from December 17 to December 31 a complete blackout for and League or Exhibition games?

- Yes. This allows for a fourteen (14) "wash-out" period before game play starts again in January. Teams may practice and enjoy the Holiday season.
