1. RAMP Coach Profile

• BYSI Registration: Log into <u>RAMP</u>.

2. Criminal Record & Vulnerable Sector Check (CRC/VSC)

• Must have a valid CRC/VSC that is dated within two years, and valid throughout the entire season

If you need a CRC/VSC go to the BYSI website to obtain a volunteer letter for a reduced fee

*Submit receipt to BYSI for reimbursement. *Must upload valid CRC/VSC to your coaches RAMP Profile



3. Respect in Sport (RIS)

- Must have a valid RIS that is dated with five years, and valid throughout the entire season
- Complete free online course by going to BYSI website, Coaches Tab and Respect In Sport

*Must upload RIS number to your coaches RAMP Profile



4. Create a NCCP Profile

Complete the following:

- Making Headway (MH) (Free)
- Rule of Two (R2) (Free)
- Emergency Action Plan (EAP) (Free)
- Making Ethical Decisions (MED) (\$80 submit receipt to BYSI for reimbursement)



5. Coaching Course (Active Start, Fundamentals, Learn to Train, Soccer for Life)

• Online portion

*You will need an Access Key to complete the online portion. These will be purchased by BYSI and provided to the coach. This is the minimum standard.

• On-field portion

*Facilitated by SSA. If the on field portion is not being held within the Battlefords, BYSI will financially support the coach to complete this.

This is the full completed standard.

• C License: BYSI will financial assist coaches in obtaining this.
