- Call to Order by Chairman @ 7:01pm
- Cody moved to approve the last meetings minutes. Janna seconded. All in favor.

Presidents Report

- Penalty minutes will not accumulate during tiering and count towards team minutes but will count towards player minutes.
- b. NAI will run 6 tiering games, 10 league games and 3 weeks of playoffs
- c. Bantam tier 4-6 no hitting
- d. Nov. 5 NAI will start tiering games
- e. Killam Arena rules 13 people max. in the dressing room, 10 minutes in the dressing room before and after, no showering. Sign in and Covid tracking sheet each time. Form will be online too. Teams should appoint a person to be responsible for tracking team members and spectators for each practice/game.
- f. Coaching courses are available
- g. Nets are paid for and paid from Provincial account (about \$1200)
- h. Jerseys paid for (about \$4000)
- Releases U15 a few have made it, waiting on a few U13 and U18 players to find out if they will be returning to BRK or not.

Operating Committee Reports

1. Division Directors

- a. U7: 24 players registered. 2 teams. 1 head coach, 2 assistant coaches have applied.
- b. U9: 25 players (5 second year girls). Cody makes a motion to move the 5 2nd year U9 girls up to U11 Girls team. Janna seconded. All in favor. Amy Jackson agreed to be U9 Director this year.
- c. U11: 13 players. 1 coach application. Possibly 1 more skater to register. 1 team.
- d. U13: 24 skaters, 3 goalies. 4 skaters still in Camrose. 4 head coach applications, 2 assistant coaches. Will register two teams, tier 3 and 5.
- e. U15: 23 skaters, 1 goalie. Probably one team. 1 coach, 2 assistant coaches. 2 want to come from Viking, will tell them yes. Les will email the team and find out if anyone knows another goalie and what they would like to do. Possibility of bringing a U13 goalie up? Dayland only has 11 (?) players and a goalie...we will register 2 U15 teams and register one as a tier 2 and one as a tier 3.
- f. U18: 26 skaters, 3 trying in Camrose. 1 goalie. 1 goalie trying in Camrose, 1 not being released. Talked to 3C's they have 38 kids (2 goalies). Hughenden have 15 (down to 12...9...) could maybe get a few from there? If we can find a second goalie we could have 2 teams (12 and 13). Will put in for tier 2 and 3. No coaching applications. Eilish will talk to the Hughenden president to see what is happening there.
- g. Female U11: U11 9 plus 5 novice girls (13 skaters and a goalie.) Have a coach and a manager.
- h. Female U13 11 and 1 goalie. Have a coach and a manager.
- i. Female U15 9 skaters confirmed plus a couple more and a goalie.
- j. Female U18 Camrose folded, we now have a goalie and maybe 12 skaters.
 - Female Exhibition cohorts...October 17th weekend will start. Would like to start female practices next week. Will schedule practices in Killam. Games will be scheduled within a cohort for 2 weeks, then 2 weeks off.
