

Ken Nichol Regional Recreation Centre Emergency Response Plan Fire/Evacuation Medical Emergency

BEAUMONT

FIRE/EVACUATION

The presence of smoke, odour of burning, uncontrolled fire, imminent fire hazard, spontaneous/abnormal heating of any material, or when the fire alarm sounds in a building or surrounding area.

RESPONSE

- 1. If you hear the fire alarm evacuate the area using the nearest exit.
- 2. If you discover smoke or fire, stay calm, announce the type of Emergency, and pull the nearest fire alarm. If visible fire cannot be controlled with a location fire extinguisher immediately pull the fire station and/or call Emergency Services 911
- 3. Proceed with Evacuation Procedures & Checklist
- 4. Do no re-enter the building until emergency services has deemed it safe to do so.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES

- 1. Determine location and type of fire:
 - a. Check Annunciator Panel if safe to do so
 - b. Ensure to keep away from fire, securing area if the fire is small
 - c. Pull alarm if not already activated
 - d. If the fire is small, you are near an exit and it is safe to do so, use a Fire Extinguisher
- 2. If the alarm is false (when a staff member inadvertently sets the alarm off, or a person is seen by staff setting it off:
 - a. Proceed with Staging until Fire Rescue gives all clear and re-sets alarm
 - b. Trained operations staff may silence alarms
- 3. Call Facility On-Call Phone 780-499-0661 if afterhours.

POST INCIDENT

- o Announce emergency is over when Fire has provided all clear
- o Complete Incident Report.
- o Inform Supervisor, Health and Safety and any other responsible individuals
- o Obtain Witness statements
- o Resume operations where appropriate
- Do not re-enter building after major fire

MEDICAL/MAJOR INJURY

There is an acute emergency or illness (heart attack, seizure, major injury requiring emergency medical services etc.) that poses an immediate risk to a person's life or long-term health.

RESPONSE

- 1. Assess the scene and secure, provide care, determine if conscious or unconscious
- 2. Activate alarm or call 911, contact facility first aider for assistance
- 3. Obtain first aid kit, AED and any other medical equipment/supplies brought.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES

- 1. If person is unresponsive:
 - a. Call Emergency Services 911
 - b. Proceed with first aid where applicable: check for breathing, perform CPR, attach, and use AED, complete Vital Sheets.
 - c. Secure the scene to maintain integrity
- 2. If person is responsive but medical is threatening or requires further medical assistance call Emergency Services 911
- 3. If there is a suspicion of an overdose or it is an overdose:
 - a. Do not touch victim without PPE (gloves, CPR shield/mask)
 - b. Ask those around the victim what they took if any drugs or have underlying medical issues
- 4. Obtain injured person's belongings and ID and provide to Emergency Services, notify injured person's family if possible.
- 5. Keep individual secure and comfortable, remove to safe location if necessary
- 6. Remove and stage any persons away from the area

POST INCIDENT

- o Announce emergency is over once incident commander clears the event.
- o Complete Incident Report
- o Obtain Witness statements
- o Inform Supervisor, Health and Safety and any other responsible individuals.
- o Resume operations where appropriate
- Secure the scene, do NOT clean up
- o If AED is used, do not turn off or remove the battery and follow the AED Deployment Process.
