1. Purpose

The purpose of the Beaumont Ringette Evaluation Policy is to fairly and consistently evaluate athletes for the purpose of them on teams with athletes of similar abilities.

2. Applicability

The Player Evaluation Policy applies to:

- The Team Selection Committee
- Volunteers assisting with Player Evaluation
- Beaumont Ringette Association Members

3. Definitions

Terms specific to this Policy.

Term	Definition
BRA	Beaumont Ringette Association
Evaluation Session	Refers to both timed and graded events where athletes are being scored.
Timed Event / UAA	The Universal Athlete Assessment (UAA) are a standardized set of timed drills that Ringette Albert utilizes to determine a teams tier at the start of the Season in U10-U14. Scoring during timed events is based on how long the athlete took to complete a drill.
Graded Event / Scrimmage	During Scrimmage evaluations, athletes are giving scores by evaluators in a number of predefined skill categories.

4. Requirements

4.1 – Evaluations	
4.1.1	Each athlete will be provided the opportunity to attend two evaluation sessions.
4.1.2	Player Evaluation Process will be documented and available to all members.
4.1.2.1	The team selection committee is accountable for administering the Player Evaluation Process
4.1.2.2	If extenuating circumstance arise which require deviations to the Player Evaluation Process, the Team Selection Committee will report the deviations to the Board of Directors.
4.1.3	Members may inquire about what areas their child should focus on to improve future evaluations.

4.2 Volunteers	
4.2.1	The Team Selection Committee will consist of a seven person panel.
4.2.2	Volunteers involved with on-ice activities or operating benches during graded evaluations must abide by the Player Evaluation code of conduct
4.2.2.1	Volunteers for on-ice activities will be performed by previous years coaches who have a Criminal Record Check on file with BRA.
4.2.3	Graded events will be scored by independent evaluators who are not affiliated with the Beaumont Ringette Association

4.3 Team Selection	
4.3.1	Teams will be considered finalized at the completion of the selection process. If extenuating circumstance arise, as determined by the Board of Directors, substitutions may occur.

5. Enforcement

The Beaumont Ringette Association Board of Directors is accountable for the enforcement of this policy. Violations will follow the Discipline and Complaints Policy.
