For U12 and U14 team selection, scrimmage scores from 2019 evaluations will be used. To calibrate between age groups, lower division scrimmage scores will be reduced by 20%.	RAB has revoked game sanctioning, as per variance 1.0. As game-play ability is an important factor in determining team placement, BRA will use the most recent available data.

RAB has revoked game sanctioning, as per variance 1.0, so scrimmages are not possible. At U16, skating ability is not considered (other than as it pertains to scrimmage scores), so no 2020 data on player ability can be gathered. That, combined with the player movements from U14 to allow for the formation of viable teams, makes comparable rankings impractical.

Rinas	Dressing Room Policy – Parental Entry	Parental entry restriction relaxed to allow skate-tying, etc. to occur in dressing rooms with oversight of a qualified female.	Requiring skate tying to occur in common areas causes congestion and may lead to increased virus exposure. And since players are required to arrive fully dressed except for				

			skates, helmets, and gloves, the 'dressing room' is temporarily not a place where athlete can be in any state of undress.
