about the possibility of teams purchasing their own jerseys to put name bars on. This is to be mentioned in the manager meeting.

• **50-50 Ticket Prices** - could these be increased to \$10. Board is exploring using Raffle Box.

Can purchase a machine for raffle box
Set up fee is \$500, plus \$800 for machine
7% fees for total sales + Stripe fees of 2.99%
The tournament that used Rafflebox lost more than 50% of their profit but they also sold more 50/50 compared to other age divisions
