3. Approval of Minutes from August 26, 2024 Meeting

4. Webmaster Update – Lee Shalapay

Nothing significant for updates.

Exhibition game request button has been added to the website. Been up and running since past Saturday and have booked ~30 games already. Seems to be working well.

Re: Stats – we need to make sure that we are filling out all the information needed on the game sheets.

Rob – We were pretty lenient with submissions; however, this season we will be looking to achieve 100% submission. Lee and I will both be reaching out to managers regarding errors and omissions throughout the season and especially during the first few games of the season.

Remember that the spectator liaison needs to be added to the game sheet.

We also want to see goalie information being filled out properly, as well as stats recorded.

Question: Can we have the right option available to bill for exhibition games (Colleen Caldwell - SARA).

Sylvie – we will not be doing that. We will bill the home team and that team can track down payment if they aren't supposed to be billed.

5. RIC Update – Sylvie Dubois

For reschedules, we will be forwarded all requests to the appropriate RIC. Once refs have been assigned, notification will go out that the game is a go.

We've had 82% return rate for refs which is great. We have lots of refs ready to get back on the ice.

I hope everyone has a really great season.

6. Scheduler Update – Sandra Fenton

Outstanding item from start-up meeting re: U19AA number of games.

RAB has reached out to us to let us know that they will be using league standings only going forward for provincials. RAB is looking for 2 full sessions to have appropriate information to set standings for provincial ranking.

Based on this, we would stay with the same game # as past seasons.

Session 1 would be 4 games. Session 2 would be 12 games. All games would be over a regular period of time. The split would allow RAB to have their 12 games needed to provincial ranking.

Cheryl Barnabe (CGY AA) – Session 1 would not count for standings.

Sandra – Yes, and tournaments would also not count.

Jody Cherdarchuk (ERC) – We couldn't do equal round robins in the past but now we can?

Sandra – Yes, with the 4 games in session 1 this will remove the uneven game # against other teams.

Amanda Forster (SPRA) – Will we be doing hubs where teams play a few games in the same weekend?

Sandra – We've already have a hub Oct 19-20 booked for the north. We are hoping to do one in the south, but it all depends on the ice availability.

Wayne – Is a change from operating manual. Can you please motion for this.

Sandra Fenton motions for the 2024/25 season that U19AA teams will play 16 games – 4 games in session 1 and 12 games in session 2. Cheryl Barnabe (CGY AA) Seconds.

Sherwood Park U19B OA Goalies – Discussion

Amanda Forster (SPRA) – We've lost 5 goalies up to this point, and we've done as much as possible to try and find a goalie for this team. We only have 1 goalie per team in SPRA.

Aaron Bomke (SGRA) – I would support both goalies playing on this team.

Janice Tymkow (PEM) What is this team declaring as?

Dan Stetic (SPRA) – we have 1x AA, 1x A, and 2x B teams.

Amanda Hatto (LAC) – We support both goalies being able to play.

Colleen Caldwell (STA) – What is the option of having of age goalies or younger goalie to affiliate?

Jessica Winship (SPRA) – we've explored this; however, we only have 1 goalie per team, so it makes commitment hard.

Gord McQueen (EFCLRA) – Tiering committee recommended 2A and 1B teams, these teams are going to be very strong plus including the strong Open B goalie.

Wayne – Launches a Poll. Poll will be reviewed and the decision shared afterwards.

Sara Emmonds (DVRA) – Can you check our submissions.

Wayne - I will review as I might have missed adding them. These were approved.

b. Declaration of Teams

SGRA – We will be monitoring our 16B team closely. They may need to move down to C.

SPK – Step 1 teams in house session 1. Step 2 teams in house session 2.

U16C Pool Size Discussion:

Wayne - we would be looking to put them in with another division to give them some variability in place. The best division to mix them with would be U14B.

Gord McQueen (EFCLRA) – Against playing younger athletes. We would prefer some sort of 16B black/gold mix.

Katie Forre (BMT) – I would agree with Gord. I would like to seem them added into 16B and play there.

Wayne – We can leave it as a three-team division in session 1 also.

Sandra – teams have 30 hours to decide how they'd like to proceed. I would need to know by Thursday morning.

Wayne – Take it away and come back to us with some direction.

FMRA U19 Level Discussion:

Wayne - FMRA are declaring at a 19B level, but their roster included a couple of high impact players. The executive feels that this team should start a 19A.

Questions/Concerns from the membership:

Karen Garlitos (EFCLRA) – RAB says they must play 60% of the games to qualify for provincials. Correct?

Wayne – Yes this is correct.

Colleen Caldwell (STA) – There are many teams that have played this team and have lost miserably. They do need to be an A team if these players are playing. If they need to adjust down in session 2 then we can do that if they aren't playing.

Sandra – Competitions committee can move teams as need be. If this team needs to be A after session 2, the committee will move them for provincials. This goes for all teams – not just this team.

Gord McQueen (EFCLRA) – Will have an impact on the goalies with the large goal differential. I would say A is appropriate to start.

Team fees have not changed - \$170/team ; \$40 / session 3 team. Session 3 includes U14-U19 levels – excluding AA teams.

Tony – I will have invoicing out by end of the week and invoices will be going to the treasurers. If associations could make sure to pay as promptly as possible.

Also, a reminder that there will be no officials' retainers issued this year. We have sufficient cash flow to issue payment at the start of the season.

Societal Act – We are required to submit a return to have our continued registration to remain a society. This requires an audit of our books by two members of the association here tonight.

In May, the membership did approve for us to delegate auditors. We are continuing to work through this to move forward and complete.

I will have this ready to note at our repooling meeting in November.

Sandra - Re fees: there will be a session three for U16AA. RAB will

not run 10/11 team provincials, so we will have to rank teams to send for provincials.

Jody Cherdarchuk (ERC) – when will the schedule be submitted for session 3 and blackout dates.
