Emergency Signals: 'Fist in the air' - call 911

'Patting on the head' - bring the First Aid kit / need assistance

Safety Person / Charge Person: Team of injured player's Designated Safety Person

- Initially take control of the situation / do not move the athlete.
- Assess injury status of player, signal if ambulance/medical care is required.
- Stay with the injured player until EMS arrives.

Assistant Safety Person: Opposing teams *Designated Safety person*

• Encouraged to assist / follow instructions given by Charge Person.

Call Person: Scorekeeper

- Tests their cell phone in the facility to ensure it will work.
- Understands specific directions and best route to the arena facility.
- Makes call to **911** if signal is given and proceeds to injured player while remaining on the line.

Control Person: Timekeeper

- Pre-Determine location of the AED and other Emergency equipment / retrieve if requested.
- Seek highly trained medical personnel in the facility if requested by the charge person.
- Work with facility operator to ensure the ambulance is met on its arrival and the quickest and best route to the ice surface is accessible.
