

Tilley & District Hockey Arena COVID-19 Guidelines

- **Pre-Screening Measures:**
 - Please do not enter the facility if you present any COVID-19 symptoms or have come into close contact with someone with a confirmed or probable case. Follow screening tools outline by Alberta Health Services.
- **Entering & Exiting Facility:**
 - **Enter** the facility through the lobby doors on the south side of the building
 - **Exit** the facility through the doors located on the southwest corner of the ice surface.
 - Participants should arrive no earlier than **20 minutes** before their scheduled ice time and vacate within 20 minutes of their booking ending.
 - **Everyone entering the facility is expected to wear masks in the lobby, dressing rooms and hallways.**
- **Dressing Rooms:**
 - Are open at this time but we ask that usage is limited to the participant and a max of one guardian.
 - Masks are to be always worn
- **Upstairs Viewing Area**
 - **This area is closed.** We ask that spectators remain only in the main lobby during practices.
 - For games, we will allow a maximum of 50 spectators in the bleachers along the ice surface. All spectators are expected to maintain at least a 2-meter distance, unless from the same household. We ask that masks be worn on the bleachers at all times.
- **Concession**
 - Closed at this time
- **Public Washrooms**
 - Open
- **Contact Tracing**
 - Ice users are responsible for contact tracing of participants.
- **Public Skate**
 - All users are expected to maintain a 2-meter distance while on the ice surface. Contact tracing forms will be in the assigned dressing room and must be filled out.
- **Equipment**
 - Bumper pads and skating assisting equipment will not be allowed on the surface
