



Volunteer Bond

The purpose of the RAB Volunteer Bond Program is to encourage all Association members to become actively involved in the operation and success of the Association. To keep registration fees as low as possible and not to rely on the same volunteers for every event which results in volunteer burn out. Many of our members are unaware of just how many hours go into a successful season, RAB is run completely by volunteers so the need for help is great.

Please Note: Only one volunteer bond is required per family regardless of the number of players registered in that family.

The Volunteer Bond: (\$300)

Applicable to U10, U12 and U14 divisions. A bond cheque of \$300 per family will be collected by the coach/manager of your team. This is a requirement before your child can go on the ice.

You must work at least 6 hours of volunteer time or take on one of the following roles:

- Head Coach or Executive Member
- Any bench staff which includes head coach, assistant coach, team manager, team treasurer, volunteer coordinator, and trainer. Note the trainer role is female only

Roles and events that count towards volunteer time:

- Scorekeeper, Timekeeper, Shot Clock
- Come Try Ringette, Equipment Loan Day, Jersey handout and collections, Tryouts, Photo Day, RAB Wear Fitting Day, etc.

All families including bench staff are expected to volunteer at the annual Blast Tournament in January. This is in addition to the volunteer time for the team.

At the end of the season, anyone who did not complete the required amount of bond hours will have their \$300 cheque cashed. Cheques would need to be post-dated for March 31st and volunteer hours must be completed by this date (end of season).
