In 1991 the Canadian Athletic Club (CAC) commenced annual scholarship awards for CAC players to pursue post-secondary education. For more than three decades, the CAC is proud to support players as they further their studies in a variety of fields to build knowledge and skills to be a strong contributor to our community.

Scholarship Awards

Each year the CAC makes available \$12,000 in scholarship awards to successful applicants.

Presently nine scholarships are available and they honor the legacy of outstanding contribution of volunteers at the CAC.

We welcome contributions to the Scholarship fund; however, as the CAC is not a registered charity, no tax receipts are available. Eligibility for a Scholarship Award

- ✓ Player for CAC teams for a minimum two years.
- ✓ Successful completion of at least a minimum one (1) term of study at a post-secondary institution in Canada.
- ✓ A player can be awarded a maximum two (2) scholarships in different years.
- ✓ Attending a post-secondary institution in Canada.
- ✓ All documentation must be received by the CAC Scholarship Committee by February 28, 2026.

Scholarship Application

Applicants must complete an application, as noted below in the link, and provide the following relevant information.

- ✓ Attending a post-secondary institution in Canada.
- ✓ Official transcripts from post-secondary institutions.
- ✓ Personal one (1) page maximum letter from applicant.
- ✓ Official high school transcripts.
