#### To: To the Attention of All CAHL Member Associations and CAHL U13 Teams

#### Re: CAHL U13 Playoff Impacts and Plan for this Season

This letter is to advise you of the intended process moving forward this season. We will be following Alberta One for the guide to complete this for this season.

Specifically, for U13:

- In the current season we are all aware how the Hockey Alberta One mandates have impacted the CAHL by restricting us to only 6 tiers in the CAHL age divisions. I have already spoken at length about this season with the Hockey Alberta Minor Leagues Committee and this will be corrected next year with additional tiers again being utilized in U11 and U13 thereby spreading out the skill levels as we used to do.
- As directed in the Hockey Alberta One Committee review, all teams make playoffs so in an effort to make all of this come together new playoff formats will be shown here.
- All playoff series will be two game total point series or round robin play as shown in the following pages.
- The U13 VP and Governors Group will advise the tiers that need to meet certain target dates where needed. The requirement is to make all series be completed in a weekend they are assigned. This will be directed by the Governors group to ensure we are done on time.
- As requested in the Tiering Round and Appeals meetings decisions we will be offering split playoffs in the tier groupings.

The following will details the playoff plans for each tier:

- **U13 Tier 1** ('A' Provincials) will have banners for the winner of the each of the colour groups and also a Tier 1 Champion Banner presented with the winner going to Vegreville. *We are waiting to see if we win a wildcard entry here! We may have another entry.*
- **U13 Tier 2** ('B' Provincials) will have banners for the winners of each of the 4 colour groups and a Tier 2 Champion Banner presented in a round robin format. There also will be a finalist banner for the runner up, both teams will be going to provincials in Lacombe. Lacombe T2R is the host of the Provincials so the following applies. If Lacombe T2R wins T2 they will go as the champion. We then also will have a finalist banner for the runner up. Should Lacombe T2R not be in the final then a T2 Champions banner will be presented and only the Champion will attend with Lacombe T2R.
- U13 Tier 3 ('C' Provincials) will have banners for the winners of each of the 5 colour groups and a Tier 3 Champion Banner presented in a round robin format. That winner will attend provincials in Redwater. We are waiting to see if we win a wildcard entry here! We may have another entry.

Additionally, as discussed at the Directors and re-tiering meeting, a Tier 3A alternate playoff will be created from the teams who in the past would have been eliminated from playoffs, are below the CAHL competitive model in the majority of their games at the end of the regular season and those teams will be drawn for venue by the end of the last week of the regular season. • **U13 Tier 4** ('D' Provincials) will have banners for the winners of each of the 4 colour groups and a Tier 4 Champion Banner presented. There also will be a finalist banner for the runner up, both teams will be going to provincials in Cold Lake. *We are waiting to see if we win a wildcard entry here! We may have another entry.* 

Additionally, a Tier 4A playoff will be also provided in a round robin format. These groups will be formed from the ones who in the past would have been eliminated from playoffs, are below the CAHL competitive model in the majority of their games at the end of the regular season and those teams will be drawn for venue by the end of the last week of the regular season.

- **U13 Tier 5** will have banners for the winners of each colour group and a Tier 5 Champion Banner presented. Consideration may be given to alternate playoffs for this tier after further review.
- **U13 Tier 6** will have banners for the winners of each colour group and a Tier 6 Champion Banner presented. Consideration may be given to alternate playoffs for this tier after further review.






