To: To the Attention of All CAHL U11 HADP Member Associations

Re: CAHL 2022 – 2023 Season Critical Dates and Updates

Please find below the update for the U11 HADP program happening in the Province this season. This will be the CAHL groups process for the upcoming season.

Survey results/outcomes:

- ~80% wish to have a north and south tier (see tentative divisions to the right)
- ~90% agree with a 24 game regular season
- ${\sim}48\%$ of respondents like the showcase weekend format the north used last season
- ~50% of members can provide ice for more than 1 game in one day at one location
- ~90% of members can provide extra ice for scheduling
- ~90% of the respondents are interested in attending showcase style weekend formats vs the North teams

Additionally

- There will be no tiering season you are in for the season once it starts
- We would like to start Oct 7th if teams are available
- We will require 18 home ice slots per team from October 7th 2022 to February 12, 2023. Do what you can, we know ice is tight, we are just trying to reduce TBA's. *Submit in the RAMP format*
- We are to give everyone two weekends off, November 11 13, 2022 and February 17th 20th, 2023 have been selected, should someone want to host a tournament these are ideal.
 - Cochrane Minor Hockey has a tournament tentatively planned for November 11 13, 2022
 - Hockey Alberta is working on an Invitational Showcase Weekend in Red Deer January 6 8, 2023 (more information to follow)
- All teams would make playoffs start of playoffs to be determined and the potential would be there for additional playoffs with the North League
- All CAHL play needs to be done by March 26, 2023

Responsibilities and Logistics

The CAHL Members involved in the CAHL U11 HADP trial League shall:

- be responsible to the assigned Volunteers and Admin support for duration of their League Play
- follow all Hockey Alberta and Hockey Canada Rules of Play
- follow applicable CAHL Policy as identified in the policy Manual. The following items are exempt from this tier's rules of play:
- No Sportsmanship Points
- No tiering Round requirements
- Game Ice requirements we are asking for 18 game slots not 12 for the season.
- Additional Suspensions Regulation 12 c will not apply
- No additional PIMS suspensions Regulation (9u) will not apply
- CAHL Affiliation Approvals following Hockey Alberta's Guidelines
- 5-minute warm up time
- Game Ice will be 90 minutes minimum length
- Play off eligibility All teams make playoffs
- No Game Change restrictions, just no changes within 7 days of games

Your ice submission needs to be in the RAMP format.
