- Lots of good discussion in our meetings. In general, Hockey Alberta is looking for feedback from the league and its members on Rule 11.
- Very taxing on our volunteers with everything that needs to be investigated in these.
- Recommendations from the committee include:
 - Ensure a fair process for everyone and have everyone feel comfortable bringing concerns forward. Have consistency when dealing with these concerns.
 - Would recommend that LMHA's ensure their code of conduct is updated and is sufficient to meet requirements of rule 11.
 - Combine all Rule 11's (11.1, 11.2, 11.3, 11.4) together for league discipline. If players receive more than one of these, it would be considered to be accumulating.
 - More emphasis on educating officials on Rule 11.
 - o As a league, we will review Rule 11 with all our members in September.
