- Nominations were open from March 25th to April 8<sup>th</sup>.

## New Business

### Critical Dates

- Due to the Thanksgiving weekend being later this season, it will change our start dates a bit. Once we have date confirmation from Hockey Alberta, dates should be up by mid-May.

### Communication Processes this season

- Towards the end of season, there was a gap of communication between CAHL Directors and teams. We will be looking to try to review our processes so Directors will have information on their teams moving forward.

### Tiering Round

- Lots of effort from the league here to get this right. We did have outside impacts affecting our tiering this season.
- Looking to possibly adding more tiers and we already have approval to do so.
- Please think about our appeal process for tiering. We are looking at having associations fill out a form if they think they would like to move down. Looking to make this process easier.

### Open Questions and Discussion

Question from Medicine Hat - Is SCAHL going to be running U11AA? Not sure if the SCAHL will exist next year, but we have been given no further information on where it will be housed for next season.

Comment from Medicine Hat - We are hoping to enter 2-U18 NBC teams this season and are hoping there would be more games we could have our teams play.

Question from Airdrie - Is U16 going to be running next season? We don't know from Hockey Alberta standpoint where they stand, but if members come to us with teams we will run a U16 division for them.

Is there a minimum number of teams to run U16? Whatever the members have we will make it work.

Question from Olds - Is there an interest level in having just full female teams into CAHL? We won't know until they are declared. At the U9 level we have 3 full female teams but unfortunately it did not work out for them to play each other based on geography

Question from Olds - Are we allowed to break U9 teams into tier numbered groups? No, as per Hockey Alberta, we are not allowed to do that as a league.

Question from Olds - Any update on having full ice for U9? We have not heard anything from Hockey Alberta as it is their decision.
