## Regular Season Overtime Rules

- ☐ Overtime starts with a jump ball immediately after the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter ends.
- ☐ Each team shoots at the same basket as the second half.
- ☐ The first team to score wins. This includes free throws.
- ☐ Fouls do not reset.
- ☐ There will be no timeouts in overtime.

## Playoff Overtime Rules

- ☐ Overtime in the playoffs will start immediately with a jump ball at center court
- ☐ The first team to score 4 points or the team leading at the end of a 3 minute run time period is the victor, whichever comes first
- ☐ The clock will only be stop-time in the last 30 seconds of the 3 minute overtime period. The clock will be stopped during the 3 minute period for team or officials timeouts, and player injuries
- ☐ If the game remains tied at the end of 3 minutes, the second overtime period will begin immediately with a jump ball and the winner will be determined by the first team to score a point. This includes any type of point scored including a single foul shot
- ☐ Each team will continue to shoot at the same basket as the second half
- ☐ Each team will be only allowed a one-minute timeout for the entire overtime period. No timeouts carry over from the 2nd half of regulation
- ☐ Players who were fouled out or ejected during regulation time will NOT be allowed to participate in any of the overtime periods

**\*\*There is no overtime in 22 minute or full length seeding rounds (until final divisions are set).\*\***
