

Provincial Restrictions Exemption Program

As per the Alberta Government's recent announcement, new restrictions will come into effect on Monday, September 20th. On this date, businesses can choose to implement the Restrictions Exemption Program(REP) and continue to operate as usual or implement restrictions that would reduce or eliminate the LBCA's ability to facilitate sport, fitness, recreation and wellness activities. The LBCA will implement the REP program as follows:

Effective September 20th, all visitors will be required to provide one of the following to enter the LBCA.

- 1. Proof of vaccination
 - o proof of single dose will be accepted until October 25th
 - o proof of two does will be required after October 25th
 - Proof of vaccination can be verified via the My Alberta Health app, QR code or printable vaccination card/record
- 2. Proof of privately paid negative covid-19 test
 - o must have been completed within 72 hours of visiting the facility
- 3. Documentation of medical exemption
 - Individuals who wish to request an exemption must submit a request by email to info@thelbca.ca prior to visiting the LBCA
 - exemption requests will be assessed by LBCA leadership to determine if an exemption applies.

Show & Go:

- Monitored stations will be set up at the EAST entrance of the facility during all operating hours. All other doors will be closed.
- In compliance with the Restrictions Exemption Program, visitors will be required to stop and show one of the above documentations each and every time they visit the facility.

Additional Guidance in Effect:

- Masks are mandatory at the LBCA. The only acceptation is for individuals participating in physical activity/program.
- Youth (18 yrs and under) Sport, Fitness & Performance Activity participants must complete a symptom screening prior to ice times/class(programs and clubs are responsible for screening of youth participants), wear a mask and maintain 2 meters physical distance when not participating in activity
 - Dressing rooms will have reduced capacity to ensure physical distancing requirements of youth.
 - Participants are encouraged to come to the facility dressed.
- Spectator areas are reduced to 1/3 fire code capacity, please adhere to posted capacities
 - Spectators are limited to a single household or 2 close contacts if living alone, 1 spectator per household is recommended.
 - Spectators must be masked and maintain 2 meters physical distance
- Worship/prayer gatherings are reduced to 1/3 capacity (MPR = 30)

NOTE:

- · All facility bookings, LBCA Programs, and Craft Sale are scheduled as planned
- Tumble Time is postponed until further notice.
- · Cancellation policies remain in effect.
- When visiting the LBCA, it may take longer than usual to access the facility, please plan your visit
 accordingly.
