Before you get started, some things to note:

Returning Members – register before July 31st, for an early bird discount!

New Members - If you have never registered with any Minor Hockey Program

This is someone who has never participated in organized hockey as a player, coach, and/or volunteer. This member would not already exist in the Hockey Canada Registry. If your child has played anywhere in Hockey Canada or registered for ANY courses in the past, DO NOT create a new profile. This will result in a duplicate player profile and will render your child ineligible during the season.

In an ongoing effort to foster a safe and enjoyable environment for our athletes in this great game, Vancouver Island Amateur Hockey Association (VIAHA) has implemented the Respect in Sport (RIS) program.

At least one parent or guardian of each player registered in minor hockey on Vancouver Island must complete the <u>online RIS Parent Program</u> prior to registration. Once you have completed the RIS Parent Program requirements, Hockey Canada will create a profile for your child. Please proceed to the registration instructions. You will then choose "Register an Existing Participant" in Step 3.

Transferring Members from another Association

Players transferring from another association resulting from a move into the Campbell River MHA area must complete a <u>transfer package</u> before being allowed to register with CRMHA, in accordance with <u>VIAHA residency qualification guidelines</u>. Please note that all transfers must be approved through VIAHA and BCH. Transfer packages are available <u>online here</u>.

Once you transfer application has been processed and approved you will be able to access <u>online</u> registration.

Rep Try Outs

Should you want to try out for the Tyee Rep Teams, please select the registration package for your division – "Rep Tryouts" (ie U15 TYEE - Rep Tryouts). Your registration will include the Rep Try Out fee (\$100).

Female Players

This year you have 3 options including the option to choose JUST the Female Development program should you wish.

- HOUSE ONLY You can register simply for recreation hockey, choosing the registration package "House League" (i.e. U15 - HOUSE LEAGUE) – this does not include any Female Development ice.
- FEMALE ONLY You can register for Female Development only, meaning you will not play recreation hockey and will play on Female Development ice only. For this option choose the package (i.e., U15 - FEMALE ONLY)
- 3) BOTH You can register for both Recreation hockey, and Female Development, and would choose the registration package "House League" (i.e. U15 - HOUSE LEAGUE) and when you continue your online registration will be given the option to ADD "FEMALE DEVELOPMENT" under optional items.
