



BC Hockey Application for Minor Hockey Goaltender Replacement/Relief

According to BC Hockey Policy 7.01, if a minor hockey team finds itself without a goaltender for a game/games, they may apply to the District Minor Hockey Operations Task Group Member for relief. [Click here for entire policy.](#)
Teams must use rostered goaltenders and affiliates prior to requesting relief.

Instructions:

Submit the following to the District Minor Hockey Operations Task Group Member. For same day requests, copy the BC Hockey Minor Hockey Operations Branch Coordinator.

If the District has no Minor Operations Task Group member, submit the request to the BC Hockey Minor Operations Branch Coordinator

- Completed application form, endorsed by one of the team's signing officers by signing the form or an accompanying email. For Minor Hockey teams signing officers are generally the MHA President/Secretary/Registrar.
- Written permission from the coach or manager of the proposed goaltender's team.
