You have asked, we will answer.... or do our very best to!!

Screening Forms/Health:

Do I need to fill out a form every single time my child or I come to Hockey?

Yep. Sorry, EVERY. SINGLE. TIME. Sigh...... I know! Also.... They must be filled out, signed and dated by the parent or guardian for **all** player participants. And yes this includes Players that are able to fill the information themselves, I'm talking to you TEENAGERS !! Players arriving with incomplete forms, no parent/guardian or emergency contact signature will not be able to go on the ice until the parent/guardian is located and consent and contact info ascertained. This will start this week. We are looking to make this process electronic ASAP for ease and efficiency. Think of it like your ticket to the Stanley Cup Final, World Junior Final and the Hockey Olympic Final where your FAVOURITE team is playing in a Non Covid Year! Ya, wouldn't want to be leaving that ticket at home and stuck at the door right?!?

May my Player attend if someone they live with (even part time) has a listed symptom or is being investigated for Covid-19 or has been diagnosed with Covid-19?

NO. Hard no, sorry.... this is what we are all working so hard to avoid. No person who is experiencing any listed symptom, is being investigated for Covid-19, has tested positive for Covid 19, or lives even part time with someone who has returned from out of country will be allowed to play, until they are cleared with a Doctors note. The Doctor's note must be presented a minimum of 24 hours prior to the ice time to Andrea Schulte CRMHA Risk Manager.

Do I need to wear a mask? Does anybody need to wear a mask? What about masks?!?

CRMHA can not compel anyone to wear a mask. That is a personal choice, sovereignty of person kinda thing...... BUT we do recommend them when it is not possible to maintain distance of 6 feet with others outside of the people you reside with. It is an expectation that COVID AMBASSADORS bring a MASK to all shifts they are scheduled for, because practical demonstration over the last week with EVERY.SINGLE.GROUP. showed that Ambassadors frequently need to be closer than the 6 foot allowance, and they often need to raise their voices to be heard in the Arena and mustering areas. So....... if this is not possible for medical reasons or personal choice, you will not be able to serve as an Ambassador or any role that requires being at any point closer than 6 feet. Of Special Note: Coaches that are on the ice with more than 1 cohort group must also wear a mask if they are not able to maintain the 6 foot space expectation. This is a CRMHA, VIAHA, HOCKEY BC, HOCKEY CANADA, VIASPORT EXPECTATION.
